FROM THE PASTOR



Easter Season

We think of the season of Lent which leads up to Easter – and we may think of Easter as that one Sunday where we celebrate Christ's resurrection – but there is more to Easter than one Sunday! During the **Easter season**, which spans **50 days** from **Easter Sunday** to **Pentecost**, there are specific Sundays with unique significance. Let's explore them:

- 1. **Easter Sunday (March 31**st): The glorious day of Christ's resurrection, celebrating His victory over death and sin.
- 2. **Second Sunday of Easter (April 7th)**: Also known as **Divine Mercy Sunday**, it emphasizes God's abundant mercy.
- 3. Third Sunday of Easter (April 14th): Focuses on the Emmaus encounter, where Jesus revealed Himself to two disciples.
- 4. **Fourth Sunday of Easter (April 21st)**: Often called **Good Shepherd Sunday**, it highlights Jesus as our caring Shepherd. (Messiah will celebrate on 4/14)
- 5. **Fifth Sunday of Easter (April 28th)**: Features readings related to the **vine and branches**, emphasizing our connection to Christ.
- 6. **Sixth Sunday of Easter (May 5th)**: Continues themes of love, obedience, and the **Holy Spirit's presence**.
- 7. **The Ascension of the Lord (May 12th)**: Celebrates Jesus' ascension into heaven, 40 days after His resurrection.
- 8. **Pentecost Sunday (May 19**th): Marks the outpouring of the **Holy Spirit** upon the apostles, empowering them for ministry.

Did You Know?


In 2024, Messiah will mark its 70th anniversary since being officially organized as a church!

Ground was broken for the new church building on March 28, 1954.

The cornerstone for the new building was laid on June 27, 1954.

The church building that we worship in today was dedicated on November 28, 1954.

Our campus has gone through various changes through the years, including the addition of the education wing in 1964, the addition of the bell tower in 1969 – and its eventual demolition in 2009 due to crumbling bricks. We've had a few renovations of the chancel area – going from paneling and burgundy velvet drapes – to green stones to our current cream color sheet rock with the beautiful, colorful back drops. After several revisions, we were able to dedicate a new space in 2014 that includes an accessible entrance and



bathrooms, along with a larger gathering space.

After the building was completed, Godfrey Lindstrom who donated the land for Messiah and was its original builder wrote:

"Yes, now we are all ready to start building.

Building a mighty, kind, humble and friendly congregation
to walk the way, and say the words, and do the things that Jesus wants us to.

We are here to carry on the work for Him."

One recent volunteer stopped to share information on Oak Street Health, a new health care service of physicians for older adults. He

Ouilts & Kits

A Facebook post from Martha Piedrasanta, an administrator from Lutheran World Relief Quilts & Kits ministry:

"It gets very, very bitterly cold at night," says Leyla Güleryüz (right). One year after the earthquake in Türkiye destroyed their home, she still lives in a tent with 9 other people, including her chronically ill parents and an

infant nephew. (She is pictured with her mother Seher Güleryüz, who is currently undergoing cancer treatment.)

Leyla was grateful when a Lutheran World Relief Quilt & Kit distribution reached them. This year, your generosity distributed 11,880 Lutheran World Relief Mission Quilts, 14,440 Personal Care Kits and 5,760 Baby Care Kits to families affected by the earthquake in February 2023.


